



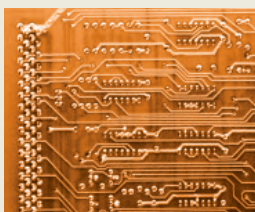
STATE FISCAL-STABILIZATION FUND

- Funding to states for K-12 and higher education **\$39.5 billion**
- State incentive and innovation grants, to be awarded by the U.S. Department of Education **\$5 billion**
- Funding to states for priority needs, including education **\$8.8 billion**
- Funding to U.S. territories, Bureau of Indian Affairs, and oversight **\$300 million**



SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION

- School construction bonds **\$22 billion**
- Expansion of Qualified Zone Academy Bonds, used for school renovation and repairs **\$2.8 billion**



TECHNOLOGY

- Enhancing Education Through Technology **\$650 million**
- Statewide data systems **\$250 million**
- Rural broadband* **\$7.2 billion**



GENERAL K-12 EDUCATION

- Title I **\$13 billion**
- Education for homeless students **\$70 million**
- Impact aid to help districts that have a low property-tax base because of federal property or installations **\$100 million**
- School food-service equipment, U.S. Department of Agriculture **\$100 million**



TEACHERS

- Teacher Incentive Fund, for pay-for-performance programs **\$200 million**
- Improving teacher quality through competitive grants to states **\$100 million**
- Funding to National Science Foundation to develop teachers in STEM subjects and improve instruction **\$100 million**



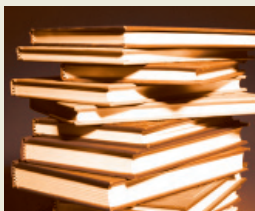
SPECIAL EDUCATION

- Individuals with Disabilities Education Act state grants **\$11.3 billion**
- IDEA preschool grants **\$400 million**
- IDEA grants for infants and toddlers **\$500 million**
- Vocational rehabilitation **\$600 million**



EARLY EDUCATION

- Child Care Development Block Grant, Department of Health and Human Services **\$2 billion**
- Head Start **\$1 billion**
- Early Head Start **\$1.1 billion**



HIGHER EDUCATION

- Pell Grants **\$15.6 billion**
- American Opportunity Tax Credit for college tuition **\$13.9 billion**
- College work-study **\$200 million**
