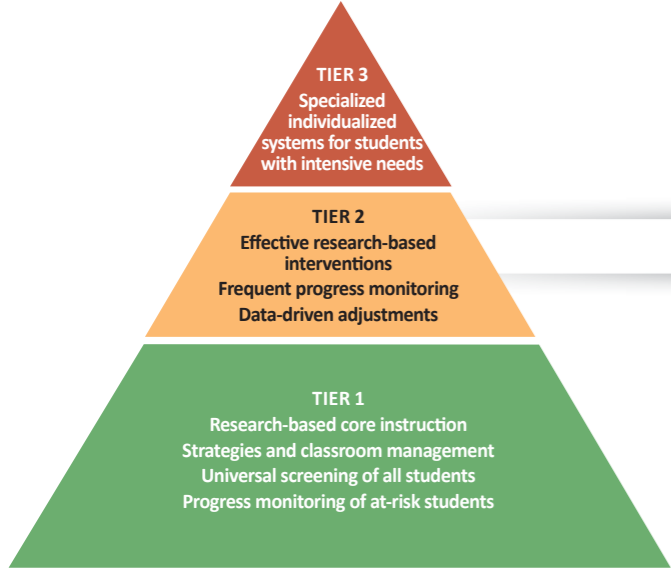
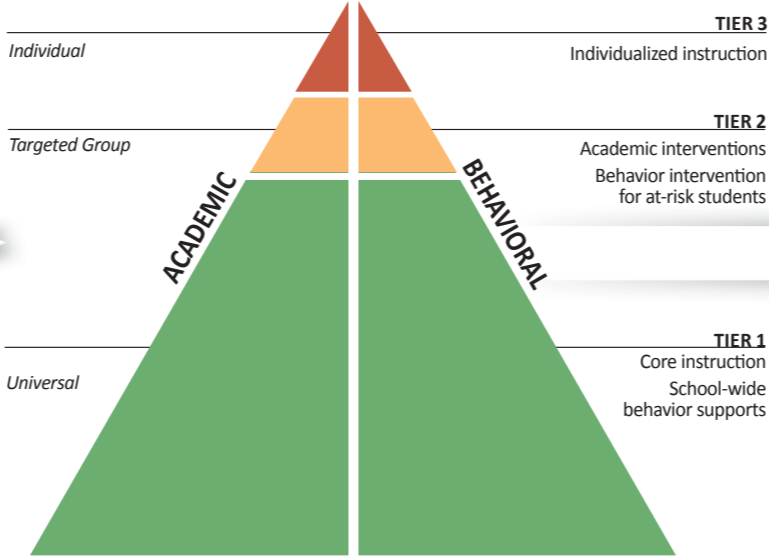


# THE EVOLUTION OF RTI

The basic “pyramid of interventions,” below, became a well-known symbol of response to intervention because it gives a quick visual representation of how an RTI program can function in schools. Some depictions evolved to show how RTI fits in a model of academic as well as behavioral supports for students. Below right, the National Center on Response to Intervention now promotes an even more complex visual model of RTI.
